**DROWNING IN THE DESERT: THE EXTREME WORLD OF CAVE DIVING,  
ON "PRIMETIME: THE OUTSIDERS," TUESDAY, MARCH 20**

Imagine going so deep underwater that you risk getting trapped in darkness or becoming paralyzed under the immense water pressure. This week, **Jay Schadler** takes a fascinating look inside the extreme world of cave divers from the Kalahari Desert in South Africa. The program follows a journey of intense friendship and heartbreak, as an elite group of explorers go deep underwater to a place known as Bushman's Hole and set out to recover the body of one of their own. "Primetime: The Outsiders" airs **TUESDAY, MARCH 20** (9:00-10:00 p.m., ET) on the ABC Television Network.

Bushman's Hole is a prehistoric crater whose beauty can't be appreciated from the air or even the ground, but only from deep below in a fresh water cavern that is tall enough to hold the Eiffel Tower. At nearly 1000 feet deep, the cave lures the most experienced technical divers in the world. Verna Van Schaik is one of a handful of divers who has dived dangerously deep in Bushman's Hole, risking her life. She says, "that's the lure, that's the danger... you kind of are able to logic yourself into the fact that the risks probably aren't so real."

During the report, Schadler follows the unpredictable journey of divers Don Shirley and Dave Shaw. When Dave Shaw set out to break records in Bushman, he intended not only to descend nearly 900 feet during his deep dive, but to explore as well. What he found was the body of another diver, Deon Dreyer, who had gone missing on a similar dive a decade earlier. Soon after, Shaw proposed an incredibly risky venture to the deceased diver's family, a deep water retrieval of the remains. The hour-long story takes viewers along on an unprecedented and complex dive, as Dave and Don set out to recover Dreyer's body and achieve the deepest underwater body recovery in history. The adventure proves to have an unexpected and fateful outcome.
