ABC.COM LAUNCHES FIRST-EVER ORIGINAL SHORT-FORM SERIES WITH “VOICEMAIL”

Imaginative Online Project Inspired by Ten Years of Saved Phone Messages

Dedicated to expanding its network and channel brands across multiple platforms and connecting viewers with their favorite shows anytime and anywhere, Disney-ABC Television Group's ABC.com is launching, for the first time in its history, an original series of video shorts entitled “Voicemail.”

Inspired by a decade of saved phone messages from co-creator Michael Wilde, the never-before-seen collection of humorous, fictionalized vignettes captures the life of Mike, a twentysomething slacker male in pursuit of happiness... and the avoidance of all responsibility.

The 25 Bachelorettes Who Look to Capture the Handsome Doctor’s Heart Are Revealed

What do a woman with strong morals, a daredevil, a voluptuous vixen, a patriotic medical student, a sorority girl with a secret and a party girl who’s not afraid to get down and dirty all have in common?

They’re all in the hunt for U.S. Naval Lieutenant Andy Baldwin, M.D., when the tenth edition of ABC’s popular romance reality series, “The Bachelor: Officer and a Gentleman,” premieres **MONDAY, APRIL 2** (9:45-11:00 p.m., ET), on the ABC Television Network.

In the premiere episode, “1001,” the bachelorettes arrive to party and meet Andy, and are quick to find out that the competition starts immediately – right as they get out of their cars. This time it really is a “first impression” rose that Andy must deliver to one lucky lady as she arrives, and it’s enough to send daggers flying between the 25 new bachelorettes.

Coincidentally, this first night also happens to be Andy’s 30th birthday, and the news spreads like wildfire around the room. The bachelorettes pull out all the stops to impress Andy: Linda, a female body-builder, challenges him to a push-up contest, Stephanie W, an acrobatic bachelorette, is so taken by the Bachelor that she literally does back flips for him in her evening dress in a must-see demonstration, and Tina treats Lieutenant Baldwin to a patriotic serenade of “The Star Spangled Banner.”
